### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Brian S. Bibean, an employee of the Department of Correction.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the office of the Department
- 2 of Correction, shall establish a sick leave bank for Brian S. Bibean, an employee of the
- 3 Department of Correction. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or
- 4 more sick, personal, or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Brian S Bibean. Whenever
- 5 Brian S Bibean terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave
- 6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave
- 7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability
- 8 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave back as determined by the department.
