### AN ACT RELATIVE TO JURY DUTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary. Any individual denied a firearm identification card for
- 2 the purposes of employment shall be exempt from performing jury duty until such time as said firearm identification
- 3 card is granted.
