AN ACT RELATIVE TO MBTA TORT REFORM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 38 of chapter 161A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the word “death.” and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following words:- death; provided further, that the authority shall not be liable for punitive
- 4 damages or for any amount in excess of one hundred thousand dollars.
