RESOLVE

Resolved,

1 That a special commission, to consist of 2 members of the senate, 3 members of the house of
2 representatives, and 2 persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose of
3 making an investigation and study relative to the feasibility and costs associated with creating a dog
4 behaviorist rehabilitation center for aggressive and dangerous dogs. Said center shall be professionally
5 staffed with certified canine behaviorists and rehabilitation specialists.
