AN ACT RELATIVE TO LIQUOR LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:
- 3 No license shall be granted or renewed under the provisions of this section until the applicant or
- 4 licensee provides proof of coverage under a liquor liability insurance policy that at a minimum
- 5 the policy insures the establishment for at least \$250,000 is required.
