AN ACT RELATIVE TO DAVID BURGESS AND THE STATE BOARD OF RETIREMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 32 of the General Laws or any other general or special
- 2 law to the contrary, the state board of retirement shall consider the age of David Burgess to be 55
- 3 at the time of his retirement in 1991 for the purpose of recalculating his retirement benefits
- 4 pursuant to the provisions of said chapter 32.
