AN ACT TO ALLOW SINGLE FAMILY HOMEOWNERS TO DEDUCT THEIR MUNICIPAL
WATER, SEWER AND TRASH FEES FROM THEIR STATE INCOME TAX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Part B of Section 3 Chapter 62 of the General Laws as appearing in the
2 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subparagraph (4) the following
3 subparagraph:-
4 (5) an amount equal to the municipal fees for water, sewer, and refuse collection fees incurred by
5 an individual for his principle place of residence in the Commonwealth.
