AN ACT RELATIVE TO WATER METER TESTING FEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 39 I of Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting in the
2 first sentence, after the words “rate for such quarter or”, the word “billing”; and is further amended in the
3 third sentence by striking out the words “and in no case shall the expense so required to be paid exceed
4 three dollars for each examination and test” ; and is further amended in the third sentence by striking out
5 the words “two per cent of accuracy” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- “American
6 Water Works Association (AWWA) accuracy standards”.
