AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE VACATION RIGHTS OF A CERTAIN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRIAL COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, and in order to  
2 satisfy a moral obligation, John J. McAuliffe, an employee of the trial court of the  
3 Commonwealth, shall be entitled to 5 weeks of vacation, annually.
