An Act designating a certain pedestrian path in the city of Fall River and the town of Somerset as the Army Pvt. Michael E. Bouthot Pedestrian Path.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: The pedestrian path to be built on the new bridge on State Highway Route 6,  
2 spanning over the Taunton River and connecting the City of Fall River and the Town of Somerset shall be  
3 designated and known as the “Army Pvt. Michael E. Bouthot Pedestrian Path.” The department of  
4 highways shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with the  
5 standards of the department.
