An Act exempting the position of deputy chief of police in the town of Wakefield from provisions of the civil service law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The position of Deputy Chief of Police in the Town of Wakefield shall be exempt  
2 from the provisions of Chapter 31 of the General Laws.

3           SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall not impair the civil service status of  
4 any incumbent holding the office of Deputy Chief of Police in the Town of Wakefield on the effective  
5 date of this Act.

6           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
