AN ACT PROMOTING FAIRNESS FOR WORKERS REQUALIFYING FOR UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (e) of section 25 of chapter 151A, as appearing in the 2006 official edition, is
2 hereby amended by striking the first clause in lines 109 to 112 appearing before (1), and replacing it with
3 the following:-
4 “For the period of unemployment next ensuing and until the individual has had at least eight weeks of
5 work and earned an amount equivalent to or in excess of eight times the individual’s weekly benefit
6 amount after the individual has left work.”
