AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE POLICE OFFICERS TO TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS OUTSIDE  
THEIR JURISDICTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after  
2 section 98 G, as appearing in the 2000 Official Edition, the following section: - Section 98H. A  
3 police officer of a city or town who is empowered to make arrests within a city or town may,  
4 while on official duty in a city or town that borders their own jurisdiction, take any legal action  
5 or exercise any lawful act to enforce the General Laws of the Commonwealth.
