An Act relative to appeals.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 20A ½ of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 88, the words “judicial review as  
3 provided by” and inserting in place thereof the following words:— review in small claims court  
4 subject to.

5 SECTION 2. Said section 20A ½ of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further  
6 amended by striking out, in line 130, the words “judicial review as provided by” and inserting in  
7 place thereof the following words:— review in small claims court subject to.

8 SECTION 3. Said section 20A ½ of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further  
9 amended by striking out, in lines 148 and 149, the words “judicial review as provided by” and  
10 inserting in place thereof the following words:— review in small claims court subject to.
