The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act to promote the successful transition of students with disabilities to post-secondary education, employment, and independent living.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 71, section 38G, of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the definition of "temporary certificate"
- 3 the following definition:-
- 4 "Transition Services", as defined in 20 USC 1401 (34)
- 5 SECTION 2 Section 38G of said chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 6 adding the following paragraph:-
- 7 The board of education shall provide a specialist teacher license in transition services
- 8 which shall include both coursework and field experience for previously licensed special
- 9 education teachers and rehabilitation counselors to develop the competence necessary to serve as
- transition coordinators to facilitate provision of a coordinated set of activities to adequately
- prepare students with disabilities to achieve successful transition to post-school activities

- including further education, competitive employment, and independent living. The requirements
- for the specialist teacher license in transition services, as promulgated by the board, can also be
- used to satisfy the requirements for a professional license.
