An Act directing the State Board of Retirement to grant certain retirement benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary and for the  
2 purpose of promoting the public good, the state board of retirement shall pay Virginia Wise, the  
3 surviving spouse of Raymond Wise, an officer of the Bridgewater State College police  
4 department retirement benefits as provided under section 94 of chapter 32 of the General laws.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of June 29, 2004.
