An Act relative to the enticement of children online.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 26C of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as most recently amended  
2   by chapter 267 of the Acts of 2010, is hereby amended, in line 2, by inserting after the word  
3   “invite” the following words:-- by any means, including but not limited to: personal contact,  
4   postal mail, telephone, instant electronic messaging and electronic mail.
