- SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after 1
- 2 section 65A, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, the following section:—
- 3 65A½. Appointed Clerk-Magistrates, Assistant Clerks, Recorders and Assistant
- 4 Recorders shall retire from the judicial branch at age 70.
