An Act authorizing the Boston Fire Department to train and certify fire service personnel in the city of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Massachusetts General Law Chapter 6,  
2 Section 165; Chapter 6, Section 165A; or any other provision of general or special law to the  
3 contrary, the Boston Fire Department shall have the authority to train all levels of fire service  
4 personnel.

5           SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Massachusetts General Law Chapter 6,  
6 Section 165; Chapter 6, Section 165A or any other provision of general or special law to the  
7 contrary, the Boston Fire Department shall have the authority to certify all levels of City of  
8 Boston fire service personnel trained by the Boston Fire Department.

9           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
