## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Eleven  
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An Act relative to fire investigation units and arson units for investigators in municipal police departments.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 94B of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “department” in line 5 the  
3   following:- “or a member of the municipal police department assigned to a fire investigation unit  
4   or arson unit to investigate fire in a municipality which has 100 or more fires annually.”
