An Act relative to the joint force national guard headquarters in the town of Milford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 33 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
2	Official Edition is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-
3	The joint force headquarters of the national guard shall be located in the town of Milford.
4	SECTION 2. Section 126 of said chapter 33 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
5	striking out, in line 5, the words "or air installations" and inserting in place thereof the following
6	words:-, air installations joint force headquarters in the town of Milford.
7	SECTION 3. Section 128 of said chapter 33 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
8	striking out, in line 8, the words "or facility" and inserting in place thereof the following words:-
9	facility or joint force headquarters.
