Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 3B of chapter 21E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in line 30, by inserting after the word "excluding", the
- 3 following words:-
- 4 "counties, cities, towns and"
- 5 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the fees owed
- 6 by counties, cities, and towns prior to this act shall be waived.
