An Act further encouraging the deleading of residential units.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (e) of section 6 of chapter 62 of the Massachusetts General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the words “one  
3 thousand five hundred dollars per dwelling unit” and inserting in place thereof, the words: “three  
4 thousand dollars per dwelling unit”.

5           SECTION 2. Said subsection (e) of section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as  
6 appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby further amended by striking the words “five  
7 hundred per dwelling unit” and inserting in place thereof the words: “one thousand dollars per  
8 dwelling unit”.
