An Act designating a certain section of state highway Route 53, Washington Street, in the city of Weymouth as the Stephen T. O'Donnell Memorial Highway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The section of state highway Route 53 (Washington Street) from the Hingham Town  
2 Line to the end of state highway at the junction of Broad Street in the city of Weymouth shall be  
3 designated and known as the Stephen T. O'Donnell Memorial Highway, in honor of his service  
4 to the Commonwealth as a Highway Engineer and Dedicated Public Servant. The department of  
5 Highways shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with  
6 the standards of said department.
