An Act increasing the expenditure limit on the Parks and Recreation Revolving Fund in the town of Hanover.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           1. Notwithstanding the provisions of clause (4) of the third paragraph of Section 53E1/2  
2 of Chapter forty-four of the General Laws, the Town of Hanover may establish a Revolving  
3 Fund for the Parks and Recreation Department from which the town may expend an amount in  
4 excess of one percent of the amount raised by taxation in the Town of Hanover in the most recent  
5 fiscal year for which a tax rate has been certified, provided that said revolving fund complies in  
6 all other respects with the provisions of Section 53E1/2 of Chapter forty-four.
- 7           2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
