By Mr. Boldyga of Southwick, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3574) of Nicholas Boldyga for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Gina Rossi, an employee of the Parole Board. Senate Ways and Means .

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Gina Rossi, an employee of the Parole Board.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the parole board, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the parole  
2 board shall establish a sick leave bank for Gina Rossi, an employee of the parole board. Any  
3 employee of the parole board may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation  
4 days to the sick leave bank for use by Gina Rossi. Whenever Gina Rossi terminates employment  
5 with the parole board or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick  
6 leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not  
7 be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of  
8 the sick leave bank as determined by the board.
