By Mrs. Nyman of Hanover, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Rhonda Nyman and John F. Keenan for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Mary M. Stanton, an employee of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act establishing a sick bank for Mary M. Stanton.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule, or regulation to the
2 contrary, the Executive Office of Health and Human Services shall establish a sick leave bank
3 for Mary M. Stanton, an employee of the office. Any employee of the office may voluntarily
4 contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Mary M.
5 Stanton. Whenever Mary M. Stanton terminates employment with the office or requests to
6 dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the
7 extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the
8 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by
9 the Executive Office of Health and Human Services.
