Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1.

- 2 Section 12L of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 3 Edition of the General Laws of Massachusetts, is hereby amended by striking the period at the
- 4 end thereof and adding the following:—"provided, however, no physician shall intentionally
- 5 perform such an abortion with the knowledge that the mother is seeking the abortion solely on
- 6 account of the sex of the unborn child."

7 SECTION 2.

- 8 Section 12M of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 9 Edition of the General Laws of Massachusetts, is hereby amended by striking the period at the
