An Act relative to controlled substances.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of Class B of Section 31 of Chapter 94C of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, shall be amended by inserting the following  
3 item:-

4 (9) Kratom (*Mitragyna speciosa*), or any salt, compound, derivative, or preparation of  
5 kratom, and any salt, compound, derivative, or preparation thereof which is chemically  
6 equivalent or identical with kratom.

7 SECTION 2. Subsection (e) of Class C of Section 31 of Chapter 94C of the General  
8 Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, shall be amended by inserting the following  
9 items:-

10 (16) Salvia Divinorum;

11 (17) Salvinorin A;

12 (18) Catha Edulis.

13 SECTION 3. Subsection (12) of the definition of “Drug paraphernalia” under Section 1  
14 of Chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, shall be amended  
15 by adding the following items:-

16 (p) blunt wrappers;

17 (q) rose bud smoking pipes.
