Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by striking out in lines 242 to 244 the following words:-
