An Act prohibiting state employees from receiving multiple salaries..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1                   SECTION 1. Section 21 of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2   2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:—  
3   If a person receives a salary from the treasury such person shall not be entitled to receive  
4   additional compensation including bonuses from any other state entity.
