Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Subdivision 4 of section 5 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following clause:-
- 3 (iii) Notwithstanding the provisions of clause (i) of this subdivision, the teacher?s
- 4 retirement board shall at the request of Pamela Mason allow said member to elect in the
- 5 alternative superannuation retirement benefit program; provided that said member shall make
- 6 retirement contributions to the system as if said member had elected into said program on or
- 7 before July 1, 2001, plus interest. The interest shall be calculated by using the actuarially
- 8 assumed investment rate of return of the teacher?s retirement system.
