An Act further regulating certain public employees creditable retirement service time for active service in the armed forces..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 4 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as amended by section 6 of  
2 chapter 116 of the acts of 2002, is further amended by adding the following sentences:- A local  
3 legislative body may vote to allow the additional time period under this paragraph as needed for  
4 any veteran who served in the armed forces of the United States. This shall also apply to any  
5 member of the Massachusetts National Guard and Active Reserve personnel, both former and  
6 present.
