An Act relative to the retirement benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special act to the contrary Frank  
2 Rizzo, a resident of the Town of Belmont, shall be exempt from chapter 32 section 91(b) of the  
3 General Laws.

4                   Section 2. The individual named in section one shall not receive combined  
5 earnings from any public employment and any public pension or retirement allowance he may  
6 receive to exceed the salary that was being paid for the position from which he retired or in  
7 which his employment was terminated.

8                   Section 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
