An Act designating a certain bridge in the city of Boston the Honorable Charles Doyle Bridge..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   The bridge on Bellevue Street, in the West Roxbury section of the city of  
2 Boston, shall be designated and known as The Honorable Charles Doyle Bridge in honor of  
3 Charles Doyle who served thirty two years in the Massachusetts House of Representatives for the  
4 Tenth Suffolk District. The Massachusetts Highway Department shall erect and maintain suitable  
5 markers bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
