**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act designating the new Bridge Street Bypass Road in Salem as the "Sgt. James Ayube Memorial Drive".

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The Bridge Street Bypass Road in Salem shall be designated and known as  
2 the Sgt. James Ayube Memorial Drive. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall  
3 erect and maintain such suitable markers bearing such designation in compliance with the  
4 standards of the department.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
