**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Louceta Hodge, an employee of the Department of Revenue.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or specific law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 department of revenue shall establish a sick bank leave for Louceta Hodge a certain employee of  
3 the department of revenue. Any employee of the department of revenue may voluntarily  
4 contribute 1 or more sick, personal, or vacation days to the sick leave bank for the use by  
5 Louceta Hodge. Whenever Louceta Hodge terminates employment with the department of  
6 revenue or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank  
7 shall be transferred to the department of revenue paid leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not  
8 be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitates the establishment of  
9 the sick leave bank as determined by the department of revenue.
