An Act authorizing the town of Newbury to use certain fund balances for capital expenditures.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 20 of chapter 44 of the  
2 General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the balances remaining in the  
3 Town of Newbury's treasury from the sale of bonds for the purposes of paying for projects to cap  
4 the town's former landfill and construct the town's present transfer station may be expended  
5 without further appropriation by the Newbury Board of Selectmen for any purpose or purposes  
6 for which the town is authorized to incur debt for a period of five years or more.

7                   SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
