An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Pepperell as the veterans bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The bridge designated as P-06-003, and also known as the Mill Street Bridge, in the town  
2 of Pepperell shall be designated as the Veterans Bridge, to honor the men and women who have  
3 served our country from a region that is steeped in military history. The division of highways  
4 within the Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain suitable markers  
5 bearing that designation in compliance with applicable state and federal standards.
