By Mr. Timilty, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2352) of James E. Timilty and Steven S. Howitt (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Seekonk to convert seasonal licenses to annual licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises. An Act authorizing the town of Seekonk to convert seasonal licenses to annual licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding sections 17 and 17B of Chapter 138 of the General 2 Laws, the licensing authority of the Town of Seekonk may convert one currently issued seasonal 3 license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises located at 1479 Fall 4 River Avenue to an annual license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the 5 premises located at 1479 Fall River Avenue. An annual license granted under this act shall be subject to all of said chapter 138, except said sections 17 and 17B. 6 7 (b) The licensing authority in the Town of Seekonk shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other person, organization, corporation or location but it may be re-issued to a new 8 9 applicant at the same location if an applicant files with the licensing authority a letter from the 10 Department of Revenue indicating that the license is in good standing with the Department and 11 that all applicable taxes have been paid.

(c) If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked, or no longer in use, it
shall be returned physically with all the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto,
to the Seekonk licensing authority, which may then grant the license to a new applicant at the
same location under the same conditions as specified n this act.

16 SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding sections 17 and 17B of Chapter 138 of the General 17 Laws, the licensing authority of the Town of Seekonk may convert one currently issued seasonal 18 license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises located at 717 Fall 19 River Avenue to an annual license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the 20 premises located at 717 Fall River Avenue. An annual license granted under this act shall be 21 subject to all of said chapter 138, except said sections 17 and 17B.

(b) The licensing authority in the Town of Seekonk shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other person, organization, corporation or location but it may be re-issued to a new applicant at the same location if an applicant files with the licensing authority a letter from the Department of Revenue indicating that the license is in good standing with the Department and that all applicable taxes have been paid.

(c) If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked, or no longer in use, it
shall be returned physically with all the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto,
to the Seekonk licensing authority, which may then grant the license to a new applicant at the
same location under the same conditions as specified n this act.

31 SECTION 3. (a) Notwithstanding sections 17 and 17B of Chapter 138 of the General
32 Laws, the licensing authority of the Town of Seekonk may convert one currently issued seasonal
33 license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises located at 20

Commerce Way to an annual license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the
premises located at 20 Commerce Way. An annual license granted under this act shall be subject
to all of said chapter 138, except said sections 17 and 17B.

(b) The licensing authority in the Town of Seekonk shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other person, organization, corporation or location but it may be re-issued to a new applicant at the same location if an applicant files with the licensing authority a letter from the Department of Revenue indicating that the license is in good standing with the Department and that all applicable taxes have been paid.

42 (c) If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked, or no longer in use, it
43 shall be returned physically with all the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto,
44 to the Seekonk licensing authority, which may then grant the license to a new applicant at the
