Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following
- 3 new sentence:
- 4 "The Division of Medical Assistance shall ensure that any third party payor responsible
- 5 for the provision of behavioral health benefits for medical assistance recipients provide annual
- 6 rate adjustments to all network hospitals not less than the Medical Consumer Price Increase for
- 7 All Urban Consumers for the most recently completed state fiscal year".
