An Act to establish a Master of Library Science assistance program..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 19 of Chapter 15A of the Massachusetts General Laws,

2 as appearing in the 2002 Official Edition, is amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3	The board of higher education, subject to appropriation, shall establish a public
4	librarian incentive program, for the purpose of providing grants to public librarians presently
5	working in a public library in the Commonwealth, who are planning to attend, or attending, an
6	institution of higher education within the Commonwealth, or partner institutions under New
7	England Board of Higher Education's Regional Student Program, to earn a Master of Library
8	Science degree. Said board of higher education shall establish rules and regulations for the
9	program, including the levels of academic, leadership, extracurricular, and other achievement
10	needed to qualify for the grants. Based upon such rules and regulations, the board of higher

- education shall award a grant equal to full tuition to public librarians who apply from each public
- 12 library and who qualify for the Master of Library Science assistance program.
