*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 27 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Inc.", in line 31, the following
- 3 words:- "a professional from the victim advocacy field,".
