An act to allow reasonable evaluation of civil damage claims.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 13B of Chapter 231 of the General Laws, as so appearing is hereby amended by  
2 adding the following sentence:

3           Notwithstanding the above paragraph, any party may ask at trial for a specific monetary  
4 amount for general damages and for special damages reasonably based upon the evidence  
5 presented to the fact finder.
