Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6 D of chapter 183 is hereby amended by adding the following,
- 2 Each assignment of mortgage secured by residential property, as defined in said section 1
