Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 328 of Chapter 94 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the beginning thereof the following:--

3 For the purpose of this section "Person" shall mean an individual, corporation,
4 partnership, an association, joint stock company, a trust or an unincorporated organization.
