An Act relative to licensing massage therapists..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 227 of Chapter 112, as appearing in the 2010 official edition, is
2 hereby amended, in line 14, by striking the word: “nonspecific”.

3 SECTION 2. Section 227 of Chapter 112, as appearing in the 2010 official edition, is
4 hereby amended, in line 15, by inserting the word: “kinesiology taping”.

5 SECTION 3. Section 228 of Chapter 112, as appearing in the 2010 official edition, is
6 hereby amended, in line 28, by inserting, after the word “event” the following new words: “,
7 whether on a single or consecutive days,”

8 SECTION 4. Section 235 of Chapter 112, as appearing in the 2010 official edition, is
9 hereby amended, in line 23, by inserting the following words:- “or through electronic means”.
