Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 7N ½ of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the definition of "Manufacturer", the following definition:
 - "Motor or auto home", a vehicular unit built on, or permanently attached to, a selfpropelled motor vehicle chassis, chassis cab, or van, which becomes an integral part of the completed vehicle, designed for human habitation for recreational or emergency occupancy.
 - SECTION 2. Said section 7N ½ of said chapter, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 22, the words "auto homes."
