An Act relative to firefighters cessation program..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is amended in Section 101A.by adding the following at
2 the end: Prior to the termination of a firefighter or police officer for violating this section said
3 employee shall be offered an opportunity to enter a smoking cessation program. Subsequent
4 violation may be cause for dismissal.
