An Act amending occupation requirements for barbers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 87H of Chapter 112 of the General Laws are hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after the words "or practiced such occupation for at least two years in this and/or other
- 3 states," the following:- "has practiced the occupation of hair dresser for two years."

- 4 Section 2. This Act shall take effect upon passage
